




Hello and welcome to HLN's Adult Clinical Standards orientation course. All clinical standards are developed by HLN Clinical Program Committees, and its recommendations are meant to assist and not replace the clinical decision-making required for individual patient management while considering shared decision making, optimal care and therapeutic cost considerations. In addition to clinical treatment recommendations, HLN has also developed resources and educational tools to assist providers in the management of these disease processes.




At present HLN has four adult clinical standards. These standards encompass the treatment and management of hypertension, diabetic chronic kidney disease, type 2 diabetes, and Statin Therapy Management




In addition to clinical treatment recommendations, HLN has also developed resources and educational tools to assist providers in the management of these disease processes. These resources can be found on our Provider Resource Hub which can be accessed by scanning the QR code or by going to the website at the bottom of your screen. HLN's medication resources can also be accessed in the HLN Links section of the Epic encounter sidebar which is available in individual patient encounters.



Our HLN hypertension standard has been developed to increase hypertension awareness and management within the Primary Care setting. This standard includes an optimal blood pressure goal of less than 140/90. For patients who are not yet at this goal, HLN recommends follow-up visits every two weeks with a primary care provider or clinic nurse until this goal is met. HLN also encourages home blood pressure monitoring for patients who have not yet reached their blood pressure goal. Lastly, patients with controlled blood pressure should meet with their primary care provider at least twice per year to ensure ongoing hypertension management.




Chronic kidney disease and diabetes cause significant morbidity and mortality in patients and can result in higher healthcare spending as the diseases progress in severity. The Diabetic CKD Clinical Standard highlights strategies for providers in improving their patient's overall quality of life, prevention and delaying progression of established disease, medication management, along with recommended approaches to treatment and testing.



HLN's Type 2 Diabetes clinical standard incorporates lifestyle management strategies that include addressing Social Determinants of Health, chronic complication management, and pharmacologic therapy recommendations. Another important component within the standard is the "HLN Approach to Glycemic Control", to assist providers with managing our Diabetes Poor Control population.



Our **Statin Therapy Management** standard was developed to identify and implement evidence-based guidelines for management of LDL and non-HDL cholesterol to reduce Atherosclerotic Cardiovascular Disease risk in our adult patient population. This standard has been developed to promote evidence-based medical management and quality of life for patients diagnosed with hyperlipidemia.
