Treatment recommendations to assist with decision-making

Complete Asthma Action Plan every 12 months

Complete Asthma Control Test yearly or during sick related visit

Twice yearly PCP visits at a minimum

Pediatric ADHD

Clinical Treatment Standard

ADHD f/u care for patients 6-12 years of age

Initiation phase: f/u visit within 30 days of prescription start

Continuation and Maintenance: 2 f/u visits within 31 to 300 days

ADHD Medication Requirements

HLN's ADHD clinical standard was developed to improve and effectively manage follow-up care for children prescribed ADHD medication. HLN's ADHD standard addresses each phase of the ADHD measurement period, the Initiation Phase as well as the Continuation & Maintenance Phase to guide physicians with best practice recommendations.
